Future tenses – Zukunftszeitformen



| Zukunftsart | Was man damit ausdrückt | Wie man die Form bildet |
|--------------------------|--|-----------------------------------|
| 1 vorherige Zukunft | Was vorausgesagt, was man nicht gewünschen kann. | WILL + Verb im Infinitiv |
| 2 unmittelbare Zukunft | Was man von dem aussehen will oder die deutschen Aussichten werden sehen kann. | BE + going to + Verb im Infinitiv |
| 3 spontane Zukunft | Jemand weiß nicht, was passiert wird, wozu man ihn spontan auffordern kann. | WILL + Verb im Infinitiv |
| 4 Auskunfts Zukunft | Sagen, was man von der Zukunft zu tun beschreibt. | BE + going to + Verb im Infinitiv |
| 5 Fahrtzukunft | Sagen, was durch einen Fahrplan gezeigt ist. | Gegenwartstform des Verbs |
| 6 fest verplante Zukunft | Sagen, was bereits fest steht. | ING-Form des Verbs |

Typ 2


Das ist ein Wunsch, der leider nicht erfüllt werden kann.
